About Typopassage™

Typopassage™ is an unconventional micro museum network located in Timișoara, western Romania. It was born out of the need to increase the general public's awareness of the cultural and social roles of graphic design and typography.

The Typopassage™ exhibitions, workshops, talks and publications seek to showcase examples of outstanding practice in the field of visual arts and to incite a dialogue between international and local designers.

It was launched in 2011 by graphic designers Ovidiu Hrin (Synopsis, Timișoara) and Erwin Bauer (Bauer konzept & design, Vienna) as the first international extension of Typopassage Vienna. Since 2013 Typopassage™ became fully independent, with its own curatorial programme and events. In the following years it has organically expanded its presence in Timișoara by adding several new locations to the network.

Most of the Typopassage™' unconventional exhibition venues were installed in accessible public spaces (a residual passage under a bridge, the

halls or the courtyards of historic buildings etc) which were rehabilitated into public poster galleries through the exclusive efforts of the team members and the museum's partners. The exhibitions are accessible to the public free of charge.

Received with enthusiasm by the public, the Typopassage™ conferences and workshops have been honoured by the presence of well-known design professionals (Ian Wilker, Hjalti Karlsson – Karlssonwilker Inc., Ian Anderson – The Designers Republic™, Mirko Ilić – Mirco Ilić Corp., Beth Kleber – Milton Glaser Design Study Center and Archives, Ciprian Isac – Graphicfront.ro) and by partnerships with international educational and cultural institutions (School of Visual Arts NY, Czech Centre Bucharest, German Cultural Centre Timișoara).

Future plans include building the museum archive – a repository of high quality contemporary Romanian graphic design –, opening the existing graphic design library to the public, and founding a school of visual arts and communication as an alternative to the state education system.

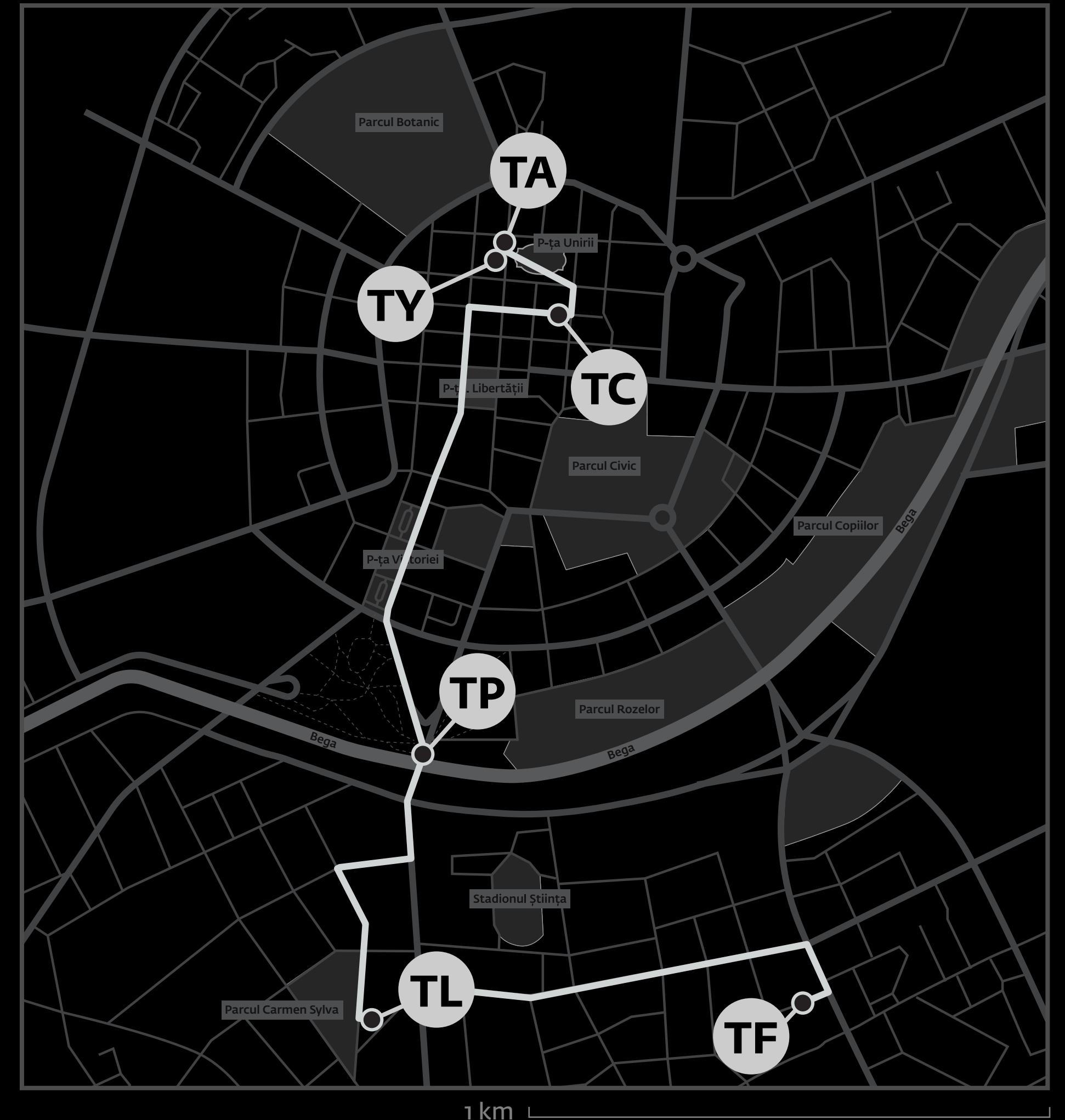

TP TypoPassage

Set up on the Bega River promenade, under one of the oldest bridges in Timișoara, the former derelict passage has been reconverted into a space for poster exhibitions and outdoor events. Its iconic TypoWall (a 30 sqm wall) is refreshed each year with new artwork.

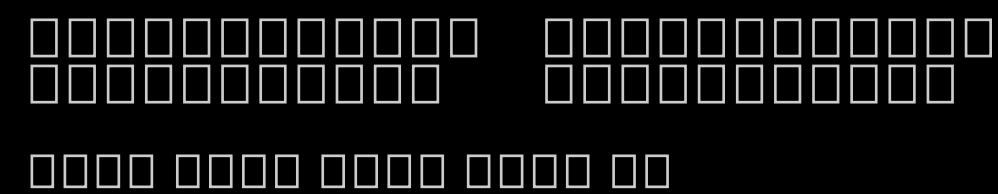
Situated in the historical center of Timișoara, TypeYard is a large multifunctional location set up in partnership with D'arc Cafe, and hosting exhibitions, design installations, talks and workshops since 2015. An indoor space for exhibitions – TypoAtelier – was added in 2018.

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The Tolerance Traveling Poster Show

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In 2018, Typopassage™ hosted “The Tolerance Traveling Poster Show”, initiated by New York based graphic designer and illustrator Mirko Ilić in 2017. The exhibition showcased 95 posters created by well-known graphic designers and artists from all over the world, each expressing the concept of tolerance in their mother tongue. Besides the exhibition the program included a guided tour and the Mirko Ilić: From Yugoslavia to USA talk, held by special guest Mirko Ilić. Two more venues were added to the Typopassage Timișoara network, TypoAtelier and TypoLejer.

The Design of Dissent is a survey of prominent graphic works of social and political protest and critique spanning the last fifty years, a project initiated by Milton Glaser and Mirko Ilić. The exhibition in Timisoara was curated by Ovidiu Hrin and Mirko Ilić, and produced by Typopassage™ in partnership with Contrasens. It was installed in the historical centre of the city, as part of "MAD(e) in Romania" a manifesto-project of exhibitions and talks by reference names in Romanian art and culture built around the energy of protests and protesting.

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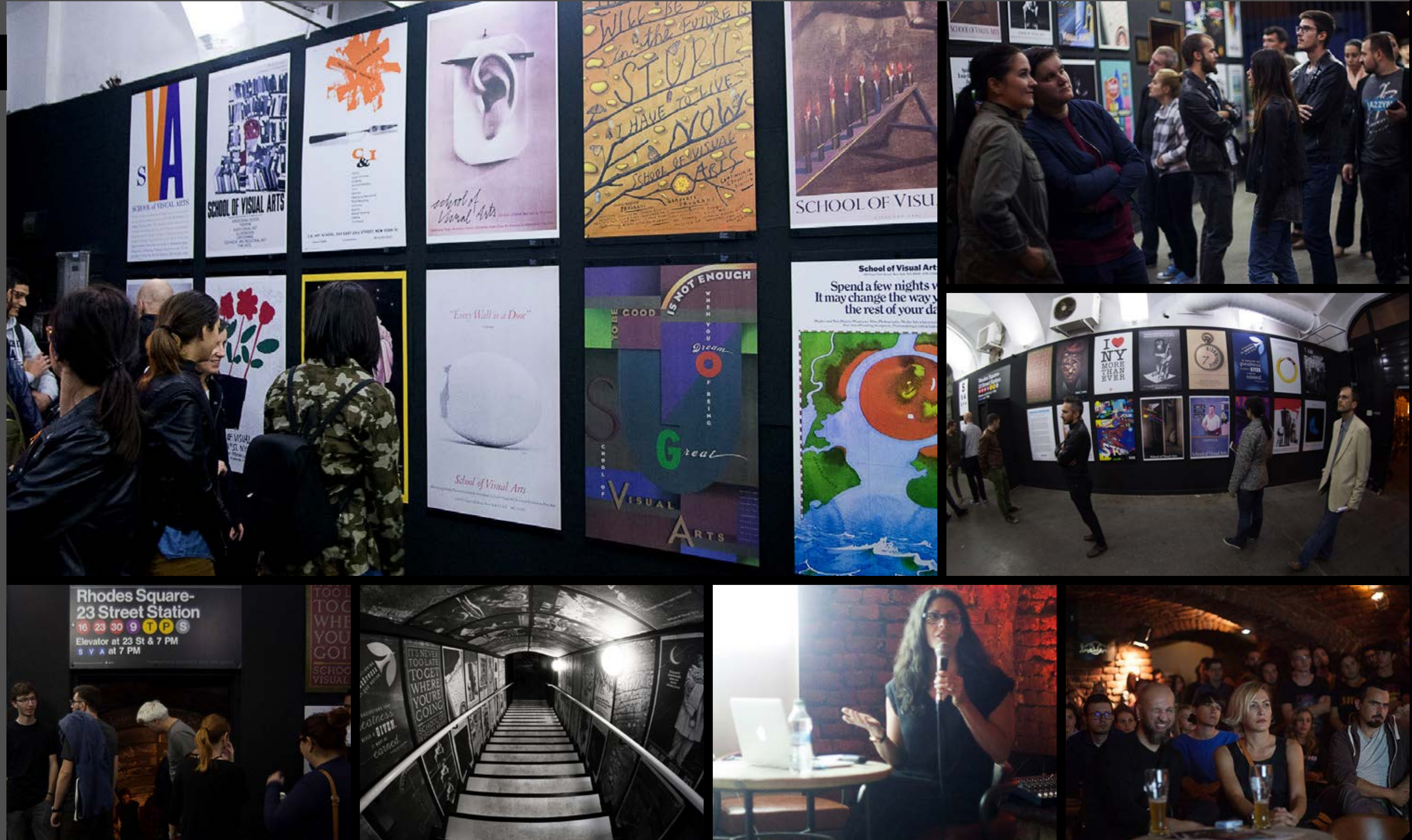

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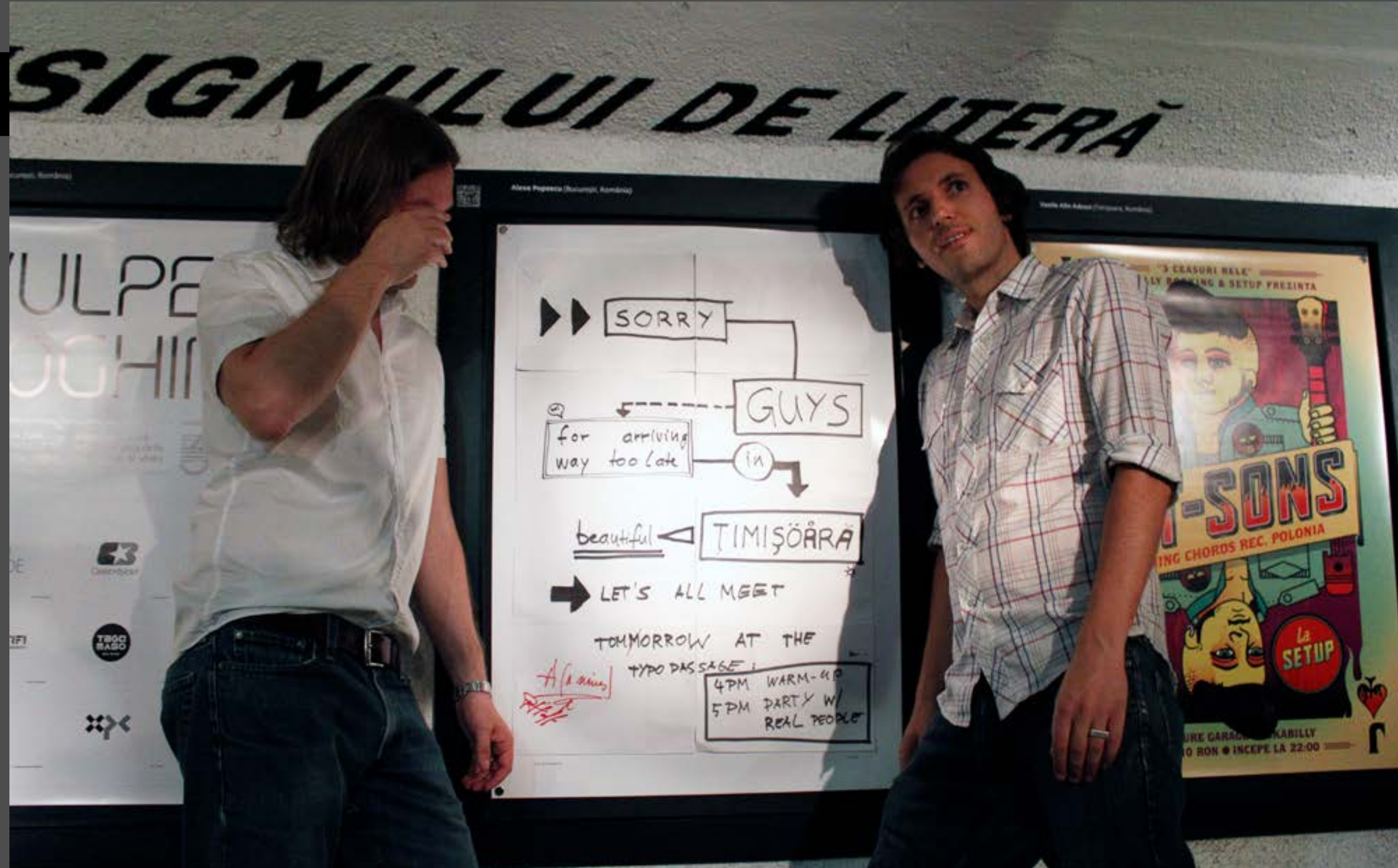

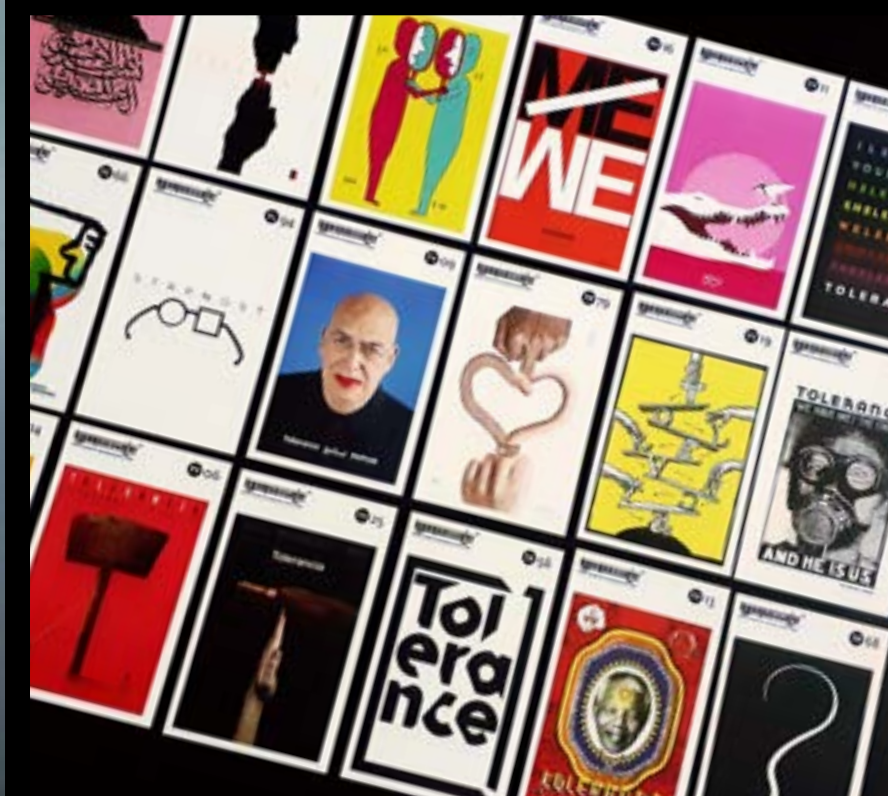

The first Typopassage™ publication was set in a magazine format and accompanied the 2012 exhibition, Nelu Wolfensohn & Ovidiu Hrin. By showing the works of the two designers face to face, the exhibition aimed to create a dialogue between two generations of Romanian designers, separated by 6000 Km and a 25 years age difference. In its pages readers could find two interview, one with each of the designers, and their byography. It also contains a manifesto by Nelu Wolfensohn (A word about posters), a presentation of the Typo-Wall and a hidden, unique, collectible poster.
